



Campground Rules

Snively, Virginia Grove, Flaming Prairie

1. Campers violating the Campground Rules, the Conservation Board Rules and Regulations, or any state law will be evicted from the campground without refund.
2. Campers are required to pay all fees for campsites within 30 minutes of arrival and have a tent, camper or vehicle on the site.
3. All sites are \$15/site/night. Online reservations will be charged an additional \$4 fee.
4. Camp Coupons available via mail or at the office: \$75 for six nights of camping.
5. **Campsite check-in time is after 3:00 pm with check-out by 3:00 pm.**
6. Campers cannot occupy a single campsite for more than 14 consecutive days.
7. No more than one camping party or group can occupy a single campsite.
8. No littering – Campers must place all trash in receptacles provided, *fire rings* are not considered trash receptacles.
9. **All motorized camping units must be kept in running condition at all times – any non-running or inoperable motorized camping unit that is not removed within 24 hours will be considered an abandoned vehicle and will be impounded.**
10. No more than two licensed vehicles are allowed at any campsite at any time, driving and/or parking off any gravel surface is not allowed.
11. Campsites can be used for recreational uses only – washing vehicles, repairing vehicles, advertising, political campaigning, hawking, peddling, or any other commercial activity, or any other non-recreational activity are not allowed.
12. There is no swimming allowed in any water source within the park boundaries.
13. **No appliances shall be allowed outside of camping units.**
14. **No indoor furniture shall be allowed outside of camping units.**
15. **Campers are not allowed to move picnic tables from shelters.**
16. All animals must be on a leash at all times; pet waste must be cleaned up by owner.
17. Fires are only permitted in grills or fire rings provided.
18. Campers shall maintain quiet hours from 10:30 PM until 6:00 AM.
19. Visitors must leave the campground by 10:30 PM.
20. Campers must keep campsites neat and orderly.
21. Minors (under 18) must have an adult over age 18 in the camping party.
