What is at Toolesboro National Historic Landmark?

1963- The family of George H. Mosier donated the land to the State of Iowa.

1966 - The Toolesboro mounds were designated as a National Historic Landmark.

1969 - The museum was constructed.

The State Historical Society of Iowa manages Toolesboro National Historic Landmark.

Louisa County Conservation provides maintenance and interpretation under an agreement with the State Historical Society.
